## **FREE BOAT SHOW RETURNS TO CATAWBA ISLAND CLUB**

PORT CLINTON, Ohio – The free Catawba Island Boat Show will open at the Catawba Island Club in Port Clinton, Ohio, April 29 - May 1, just in time to snag a last-minute deal and celebrate spring before the boating season begins.

“If you’ve spent all winter thinking about buying, but haven’t made a decision,” said show manager Ken Alvey, “I encourage you to stop by. There’ll be plenty of deals and the location can’t be beat.”

There will be no charges for admission or parking and visitors will have the opportunity to test drive a broad selection of power and sail boats on Lake Erie.

The event serves a region that, according to watercraft registration figures, has one of the highest numbers of boats per capita and greatest densities of boats per acre of water in the entire Great Lakes basin.

Boating household expenditures in Erie, Ottawa and Huron counties are eight-to ten-times greater than the state average.

“Boats of all shapes and sizes sell well here,” said Alvey. “There’s definitely something for everyone, whether you like fishing, cruising, sailing or just motoring around the bay.”

Show hours are noon to 6 p.m. on Friday, April 29; 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday, April 30; and 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday, May 1.
